

BTEC Level 3 in Dance (Single)

Below you will find some information regarding the BTEC Level 3 Extended Certificate in Performing Arts (Dance).

What is covered?

There are four units of study, three are mandatory and one is optional. Two of these units are externally assessed. Units covered include:

- Investigating practitioners work
- Group performance workshop
- Developing skills and techniques for live performance
- Contemporary dance technique

What does the course involve?

This high-calibre qualification will offer you the chance to explore dance styles, choreography and performance skills, whilst learning about the industry and employment opportunities.

This qualification allows students to give breadth to their study by choosing a contrasting subject, or to give more focus by choosing a complementary subject. Popular choices have been English Language and Literature, History, Media, Photography, Art, Sociology, Business and Music.

Quick course facts

Entry is by audition and you should have a minimum of five GCSEs graded at level 4 or above, including English and Mathematics.

Students will be given the opportunity to be inspired with trips to see performances and also have the chance to take part in workshops.
