What is covered?

There are eight units of study; six are mandatory (83%) and of these mandatory units, three externally assessed. The remaining two units are optional (17%). Units covered include:

- Investigating practitioners work
- Group performance workshop
- Individual performance commission
- Developing skills and techniques for live performance
- Performing Arts in the community
- Final live performance to an audience

What does the course involve?

This high-calibre qualification will offer you the chance to study a wide range of acting, dancing and singing styles, whilst learning about the industry and employment opportunities.

This qualification allows students to give breadth to their study by choosing a contrasting subject, or to give more focus by choosing a complementary subject. Popular choices have been English Language and Literature, History, Media, Photography, Art, Sociology, Business and Music.

Quick course facts

This course includes eight units of study over two years.

Entry is by audition and you should have a minimum of five GCSEs graded at level 4 or above, including English and Mathematics.

Students will be given the opportunity to be inspired with trips to see performances, and also have the chance to take part in workshops.
