

BTEC Performing Arts - Acting (Single)

We are delighted to offer the new BTEC Level 3 National Extended Certificate in Performing Arts (Acting). Please note that there are some entry requirements for this course. Please speak to us if you have any queries or questions.

What is covered?

This is a practical course that includes:

- Activities that support exploration of acting skills.
- Four units in total, three mandatory units and one optional unit which have a clear focus on dramatic performances and investigating practitioners work.
- Devising pieces of theatre and performing to a live audience.

What does the course involve?

This course is very practical where you will develop a supporting portfolio; there is one externally assessed unit that requires investigating skills in a written format. As well as supporting a career in the industry, this qualification will also help demonstrate and develop team working skills, and show that you work well under pressure and can communicate effectively with others.

There will be opportunities to attend practical workshops and watch live theatre. You will also be expected to attend some rehearsals and performances outside of the academy day.

As well as having an interest in the arts, you must be enthusiastic and committed to excelling. Confidence to perform is of course important, but as part of this you will be supported to grow and develop over the course itself.

Quick course facts

This course includes four units of study over two years.

You should have a minimum of five GCSE's graded at level 4 or above, including English and Mathematics.

There will be lots of opportunities to be inspired with trips to see performances, and the chance to take part in workshops.

You will need to show commitment and passion for succeeding in this industry.
