Dear Parent/Carer

Throughout the week commencing Monday 4 October, Trinity Sixth Form Academy will be facilitating an on-site NHS Covid-19 vaccination centre. The vaccination centre will be set up and run by a team of NHS staff and will operate solely for students and staff of Trinity Sixth Form Academy who are interested in being vaccinated.

Many of our students and staff have already been vaccinated, but I am keen to support those who have not yet had the opportunity to seek vaccinations and wish to do so.

A student will need to consent to be vaccinated and will have an opportunity to have private discussions with the NHS staff regarding any concerns or questions.

The vaccination centre will operate each day from **Monday 4 October to Friday 8 October**, between the times of **11:00am and 1:30pm**. The nurses will be establishing a private, well ventilated vaccination station in the Achievement Centre. The station will be screened off from view and students will be able to leave their Trinity+ lesson to speak to the NHS staff and/or be vaccinated. There will also be a drop-in service available over the lunch break.
