

# BTEC Performing Arts Level 3 (Extended Certificate) - Acting Focus

We are delighted to offer the BTEC Level 3 National Extended Certificate in Performing Arts with an acting focus. Please note that there are some additional entry requirements for this course. You will need to submit a 2-minute video of a monologue of your choice and be available for a subsequent interview with the course tutor. Please speak to us if you have any queries or questions.

## What is covered?

There are four units of study, two of these units are externally assessed. Units covered include:

- Investigating practitioners work.
- Group performance workshop.
- Developing skills and techniques for live performance.
- Acting technique.

## What does the course involve?

This course is very practical during which you will develop a supporting portfolio. There is one externally assessed unit that requires investigating skills in a written format. As well as supporting a career in the industry, this qualification will also help demonstrate and develop team working skills, and show that you work well under pressure and can communicate effectively with others.

There will be opportunities to attend practical workshops and watch live theatre. You will also be expected to attend some rehearsals and performances outside of the academy day.

As well as having an interest in the arts, you must be enthusiastic and committed to excelling. Confidence to perform is, of course, important but as part of this course you will be supported to grow and develop over the programme of study.
