Dear Parent/Carer

On Monday 7 February 'advanced Information' was released from exam boards which effects students sitting examinations this summer. Digesting, understanding, and acting upon this information swiftly and effectively is of crucial importance to the performance of students in this summer's upcoming examinations. Staff have been proactive in reading this guidance and now need to be given an opportunity to apply it into direct action.

I intend to give my teaching teams an opportunity to formulate new curriculum maps and assessment plans on the back of this guidance. To facilitate this process, I would like to utilise remote learning on the afternoon (Periods 2 and 3) of Friday 18 February.

Both year 12 and 13 already have access to all learning resources available via Teams and for this afternoon lesson, all resources that are required for lessons will be uploaded no later than Thursday 17 February. Teachers will plan lessons that consolidate prior learning, add depth and understanding to their current learning and engage with materials that will support the new learning taking place after half term.

So, in summary,

1. Year 12 and 13 will finish slightly earlier in the afternoon on Friday 18 February:
 1. Year 12 will finish at 11:55
 2. Year 13 will finish at 11:40.
2. Students who have afternoon lessons (Periods 2 and 3 on their timetables) will need to work remotely from home using the pre-planned lessons made available on Teams.
3. There will be an onsite provision for students who cannot access lessons from home or who have been already identified as needing to come into the academy by their Personal Progress Tutors.
