Toxicologist

Salary:

Between £33,000—£42,000

Qualifications:

There are two ways into this area of healthcare science:

1. Through the three-year NHS Scientist Training Programme (STP), for which you will need a 1st or a 2:1 in an undergraduate honours degree or integrated master's degree in a pure or applied science relevant to toxicology, such as genetics, microbiology, or biochemistry. (A 2:2 honours degree or better in any subject may also be acceptable if you have a higher degree that is relevant to toxicology.)

Through the Higher Specialist Scientist Training (HSST) programme, if you are already registered and experienced as a <u>clinical scientist</u>.

Job Description:

Toxicologists work in laboratories to detect and analyse harmful chemicals in body fluids to diagnose, treat and prevent poisoning.
